The Analysis 3 is not separating my laps, despite my logger has triggered all lap times. What to do?

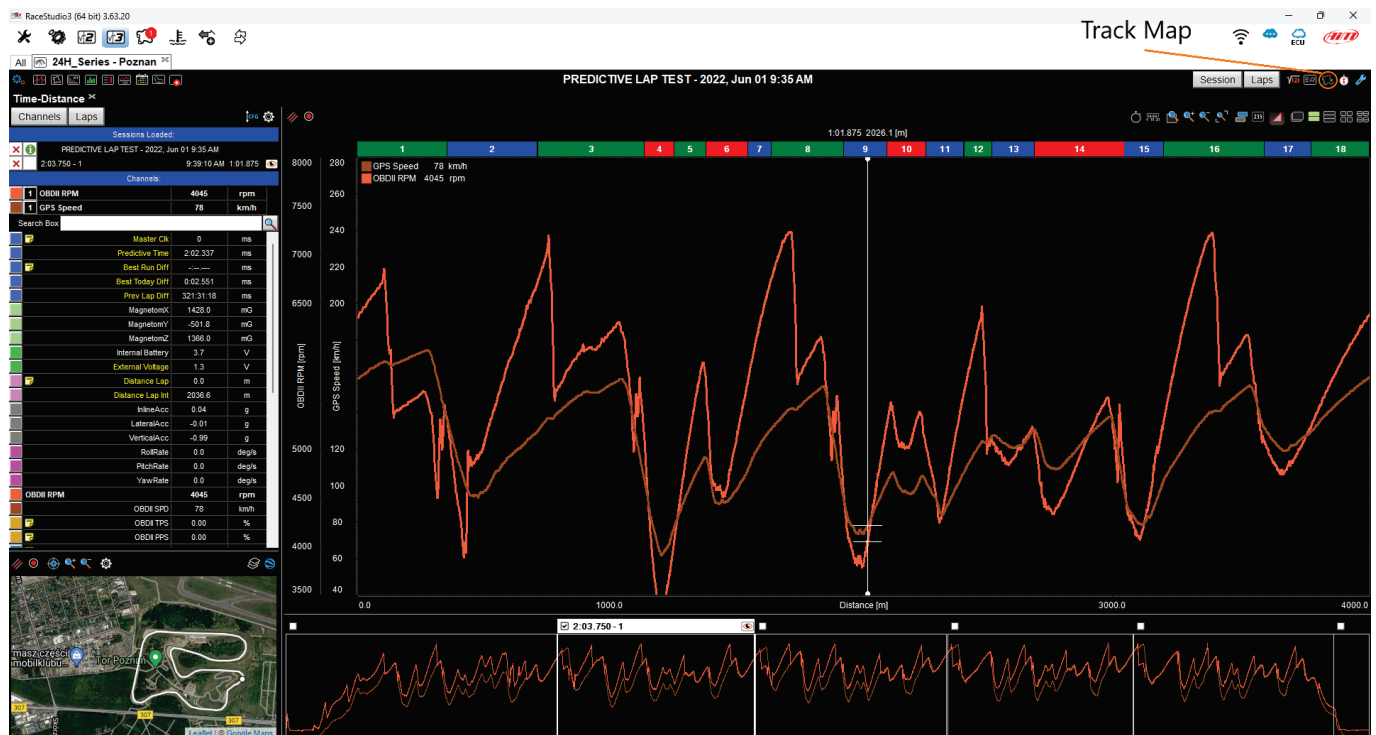
Question 2:

How can I create a new track layout on Analysis 3 using a recorded session?

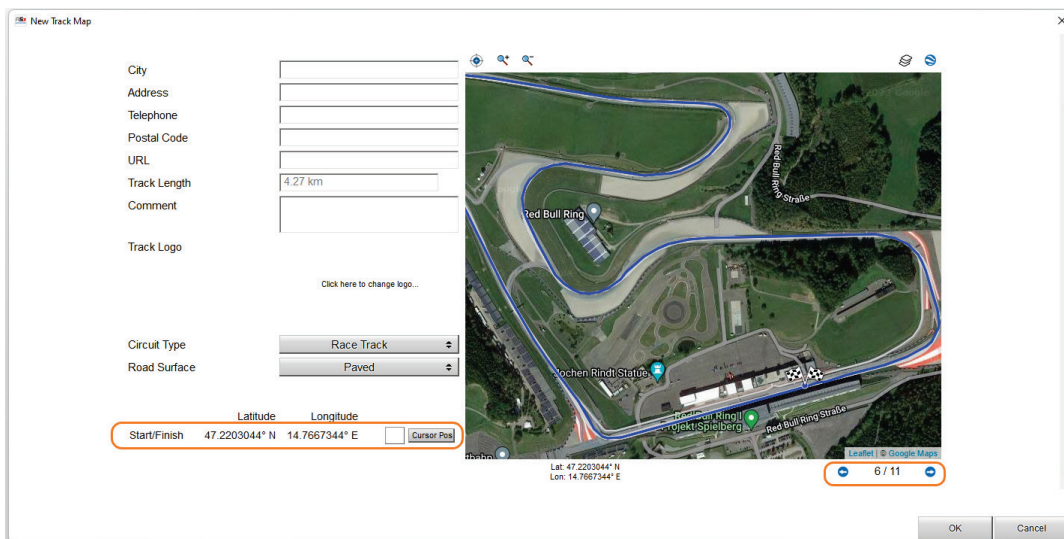
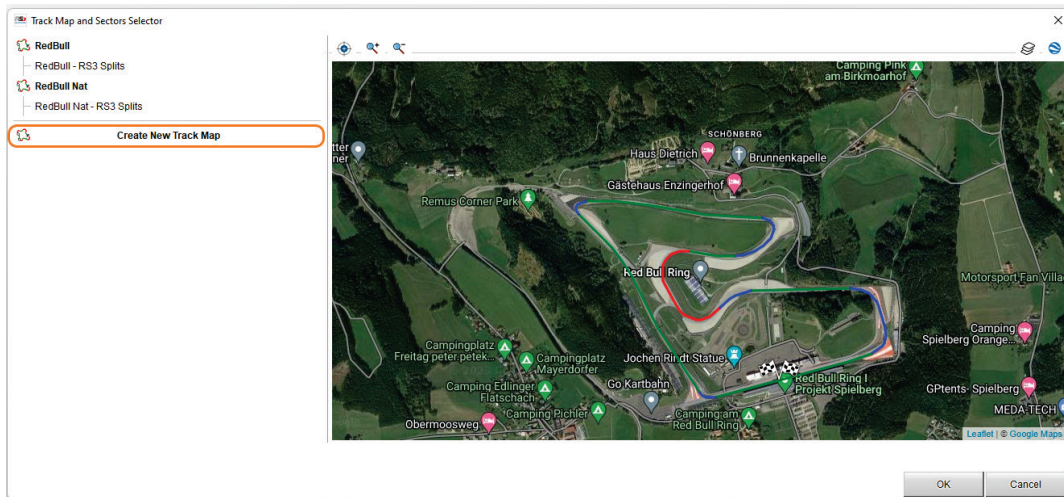
Answer:

Race Studio 3 Analysis is introducing an advanced way to compare laps and sessions. This process requires the data to be evaluated using the specific track layout, not just the finish line coordinates. If the track or its specific layout is not available in RS3 track database, you will have to operate using the **Track Map feature in RS3 Analysis**.

Once you have downloaded data from your device to Race Studio 3, open Analysis 3



- Select the Track Map icon (highlighted in the picture above).
- Create a New Track Map



- fill in all fields that the Track database requires
- fix the Start/Finish point, typing the coordinates or placing the cursor on the track map and then pressing the **Cursor Pos** button to load the relevant coordinates
- in the bottom right end, select the best lap using the arrows to scroll through laps
- save the new created course
- pressing OK the software will ask if this new track has to be used as reference also for the remaining sessions of the day. Confirm or discard and proceed with the data analysis.
